How to determine your Ring, Bangle and Necklace Size?

To help you find your accurate fit, here's a downloadable size chart. Simple to understand and easy to use, this will help you to shop with confidence because you know what you are looking for. All you have to do is download our chart and follow the instructions to determine your size.

This is a chart that will be extremely helpful for you to determine the ring size that you need. You can either make use of a tape or a small piece of string to measure the area that will be occupied by the ring. When it becomes a complete circle, make a mark on such string. This will be helpful for you to compare with the chart that is mentioned below. For extra width, you can add another size to accommodate.

RING SIZING GUIDE

Option # 1

STEP 01

- Cut a thin strip of paper or Thread
- Wrap the paper/Thread around your finger.
- Mark the spot where the paper/Thread meets



STEP 02

- Measure the length of the thread with your ruler.
- Use the following chart to determine your ring size.

Option # 2

Here is another chart that can also be considered in determining the appropriate ring size. Measure the inside diameter of a ring that you already own. It measures inside the diameter of such ring in millimetres. This is normally used for double checking your results from the usual paper method. Apart from this, you can also make use of the ring that you wear daily and cross check the same with below chart.

- Take a Ring and place it on a scale

BANGLE SIZING GUIDE

Criteria to measure Bangle size

This is a chart that will be extremely helpful for you to determine the bangle size that you need. Measure your hand, you will need a measuring tape or a piece of paper and a ruler. Bring your thumb and little finger together and measure where your hand is the widest as shown in the picture.

Option # 1

STEP 01

- Cut a thin strip of paper or Thread
- Wrap the paper/Thread around your finger.
- Mark the spot where the paper/Thread meets



STEP 02

- Measure the length of the thread with your ruler.
- Use the following chart to determine your bangle size.

Option # 2

Here is another chart that can also be considered in determining the appropriate bangle size. Measure the inside diameter of a bangle that you already own. It measures inside the diameter of such bangle in millimetres. This is normally used for double checking your results from the usual paper method. Apart from this, you can also make use of the bangle that you wear daily and cross check the same with below chart.

STEP 01

- Take a bangle and place it on a scale



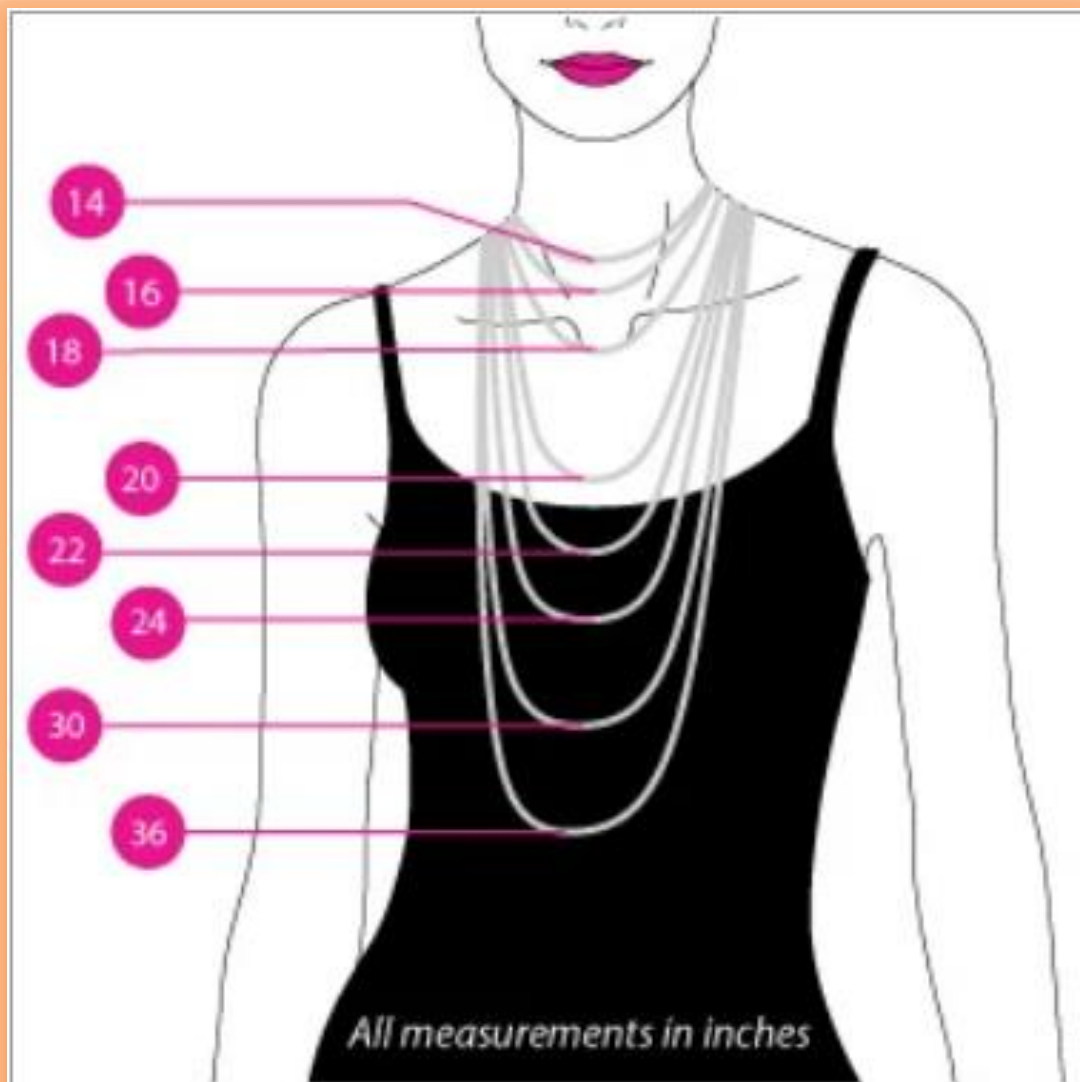

NECKLACE SIZE GUIDE

Our necklace length chart below covers most standard lengths you'll come across online for women's necklaces, pendants and chains. It will give you an idea of where each length is likely to sit on a woman's frame.

POPULAR NECKLACE LENGTHS



Standard (or princess) length necklaces (usually 45cm or 18") are the most commonly worn length and will suit most situations. If you're looking for a necklace or pendant to wear day to day, then this is likely to be your go-to length.

This length will generally sit above the neckline for lower cut clothing or over the top of crew necked and other high-necked outfits. If you're wearing a pendant at this length it will sit in a pleasing V shape which will frame

Standard Necklace Lengths for Women

Women's necklaces are standardly sold in even-inch lengths. Follow this chart to learn where each necklace length falls on the average woman's body.

Necklace Length	Position on the Body
14" Necklace	Fits like a choker and wraps closely around the neck
16" Necklace	Falls perfectly around the base of the neck like a collar. On a petite woman it hangs loosely around the neck and falls just at the collarbone. On a plus size women it might sit more like a choker.
18" Necklace	A common choice for women that sits elegantly on the collarbone.
20" Necklace	Will fall just below the collarbone.
22" Necklace	Falls at or just above the top of the bust
